AN ACT to Provide Criminal Penalty for Tampering with Passenger  
Tramways.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

17 MRSA § 2509 is enacted to read:

§ 2509. Tampering with passenger tramway

Whoever shall willfully break, injure, tamper with or remove part or parts of any passenger tramway as defined in Title 25, section 1902, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500 or by imprisonment for not more than 11 months, or by both.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill would create criminal penalties for any willful tampering with ski lifts. These acts of vandalism have a very high potential for substantial injury.
