HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 633, L.D. 784,
Bill; "AN ACT Relating to Public Safety on Passenger
Tramways at Ski Areas."

Amend said Bill in that part designated
"§1997." in the 3rd line (same in L.D.) by striking
out the underlined word "shall" and inserting in
place thereof the underlined word 'may'

Statement of Fact

This amendment removes the requirement in the
bill that an owner, manager or employee of a ski
area who finds a person in violation of section 1996
must issue that person a verbal warning and must
mark his ski lift ticket to show that the warning
has been given. The amendment, however, still
permits the owner, manager or employee to issue that
warning and to mark that person's ski lift ticket.
