HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 643, L.D. 796,
Bill, "AN ACT to Aid Municipalities in the Purchase
of Surplus State Property."

Amend said Bill in the 9th line after the
amending clause (7th line of L.D.) by inserting
before the period the following: ', except that
other state departments or agencies having an
interest in said equipment shall have the option
of first refusal; said equipment to be retained
for a period of at least one year in a current
ongoing program'

Further amend said Bill by inserting in the
last line of subsection 6 before the ";" the
following underlined words: 'and the State
reserves the right to refuse to sell additional
equipment to a political subdivision if it is
determined that said political subdivision has
not retained the equipment for the required
period of 6 months'

Statement of Fact

The proposed amendment would protect the
State's interest in the sale of used equipment
while still allowing towns to purchase used
state equipment.
