STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Aid Municipalities in the Purchase of Surplus State Property.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- 5 MRSA § 1813, sub-§ 6 is amended to read:
- 6. Surplus property. Providing for transfer of supplies, materials and equipment which are surplus from one state department or agency to another which may need them, and for the disposal by private and public sale of supplies, materials and equipment which are obsolete and unusable; provided, however, that if any political subdivision in the State requests to purchase any such obsolete and unusable items, then the disposal shall be by private sale to that political subdivision. Any item purchased by a political subdivision under this section shall not be sold or transferred by that political subdivision for a period of 6 months from the date of said private sale;

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this Act is to allow towns to purchase used state equipment in order to save their taxpayers additional expense.
