HOUSE AMENDMENT "^C " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 236, L.D. 815, Bill, "AN ACT to Clarify the Laws Relating to Municipalities."

Amend said Amendment by inserting at the end of the 2nd paragraph after the underlined word "<u>date</u>" the following underlined punctuation and words ', <u>unless such acquisition</u> <u>is approved by the voters of the municipality in which such</u> land, in whole or in part, is located'

Further amend said Amendment by inserting after the 2nd paragraph the following:

'Sec. 1-A. 30 MRSA 1901, sub-7, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

7. Municipal officers. "Municipal officers" means the mayor and aldermen or councillors of a city, the selectmen or councillors of a town and the assessors of a plantation.'

Further amend said Amendment by striking out all of the last 5 lines of section 3 and inserting in place thereof the following:

'\$5, is amended by adding at the end the following new sentences: A municipality may establish administrative areas of the municipality for firefighting and fire protection purposes, to be served by one fire department or volunteer fire association, which shall be called "fire protection zones." Such fire protection zones shall be established by the vote of the municipal legislative body or by HOUSE AMENDMENT " to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 236, L.D. 815 -2-

regulations adopted by the municipal officers if the municipal legislative body so provides.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to require the vote of a municipality approving any further acquisition of land for national forests in Oxford County, provides for a more comprehensive definition of municipal officers and provides for establishing fire protection zones by vote of the citizens of the municipality or by administrative regulations.
