STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Concerning Court Holidays and the Closing of Public
Offices in County Buildings on Court Holidays.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

4 MRSA § 1051, last 2 sentences are repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

The public offices in county buildings shall be closed to business on the above-named holidays. When any one of the above-named holidays falls on Saturday, the preceding Friday shall be observed as a holiday; when any one of the above-named holidays falls on Sunday, the Monday following shall be observed as a holiday, with all the privileges applying to any of the days above named.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act provides that public offices in county buildings shall be closed on court holidays, and further provides that court holidays falling on a Saturday shall be observed on the preceding Friday.
