HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 243, L.D. 827, Bill, "AN ACT Extending Collective Bargaining Rights to University of Maine Employees."

Amend said Amendment on page 1 by adding at the end of subsection 10 after the word and punctuation "negotiations." the following: 'The board of trustees shall appoint a student to be the representative of students for collective bargaining. The student shall be appointed from a list of 3 recommended by a system-wide student organization, whose membership shall be proportionally representative of all campuses and recognized by the board of trustees. It shall be the responsibility of the board or its designee to inform the student representative whenever collective bargaining meetings are to be held pursuant to section 1026, subsection 1, paragraph B, in which student representation on university boards, committees or councils is a subject for discussion, and to consult with the student representative prior to such meeting for the purpose of obtaining students' views. The board or its designee may meet with the student representative at other times and for such purposes as it deems appropriate.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to require that students be notified when their membership on university boards, committees and councils is a subject for negotiation between faculty and the university.
