STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Increase Fees for Overlimit Permits.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 29 MRSA § 1703, 3rd sentence, as amended by PL 1971, c. 593, § 22, is further amended to read:

the fee for such permits shall be not less than \$2 \$3 nor more than \$15, to be determined, on the basis of weight, height, length and width, by the Department of Transportation.

Sec. 2. 29 MRSA § 1703, 2nd ¶, last sentence is amended to read:

The fee for such permit shall be based upon a rate of \$15 for each 30-day period covered by the permit.

FISCAL NOTE

It is estimated that there will be an additional income to the General Highway Fund of approximately \$150,000 for the fiscal years ending June 30, 1976, and June 30, 1977.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the fees for overlimit permits granted by the Department of Transportation. The fees in section 1 have not increased since they were established in 1947 and the fee in section 2 has not increased since it was established in 1955.
