HOUSE AMENDMENT "C " to H.P. 663, L.D. 837, Bill,
"AN ACT Concerning Pay Toilets."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'§ 1577. Pay toilets

Each restroom to which the general public has access shall contain at least one toilet, in good working order, for use of which payment is not required. The term "toilet," as used in this section, does not include a urinal or any similar device.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment requires that every restroom to which the public has access must contain one toilet which may be used without payment.
