**AN ACT Concerning Pay Toilets.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

22 MRSA § 1577 is enacted to read:

§ 1577. Pay toilets

No restroom to which the general public has access shall contain any toilet facilities for use of which payment is required.

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

No person using a restroom open to the general public should be penalized because he or she does not possess the correct amount of small change.
