**AN ACT to Permit the Commissioners of Aroostook County to be Paid
Traveling Expenses in Addition to their Salaries.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 106, 2nd ¶, first sentence, is amended to read:

Said salaries shall be in full, except that in Aroostook County the county commissioners shall be allowed, in addition to their salaries, all necessary traveling expenses, for all services, expenses and travel to and from the county seat, including the management of the jails and workshops and the sale of their products, except that when outside of the county seat on official business, including public hearings, inspection and supervising construction, snow removal and maintenance of roads in unincorporated townships in their respective counties, they shall be allowed all necessary traveling and hotel expenses connected therewith.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to allow traveling expenses for Aroostook county commissioners going to and from the county seat on official business.
