STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Increase the Salaries of Certain Sagadahoc County Officers.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 30 MRSA § 2, 13th \P , as amended by PL 1973, c. 724, § 3, is further amended to read:

Sagadahoc County: County commissioners, \$1,670 \$2,021; clerk of courts, \$6,678 \$8,080; county treasurer, \$3,339 \$4,040; sheriff, \$8,197 \$10,370; register of deeds, \$6,956 \$8,416; judge of probate, \$6,232 \$7,540; register of probate, \$6,678 \$8,080;

- Sec. 2. Effective date. Notwithstanding the provisions of Title 30, section 3, subsection 1 of this Act shall become effective January 1, 1976.
- Sec. 3. Transition and retroactivity. Notwithstanding the provisions of Title 30, section 3, the following salary schedule shall be effective from 90 days after the Legislature adjourns until January 1, 1976 and shall be retroactive to January 1, 1975:

Sagadahoc County: County commissioners, \$\frac{\$\pm\$}{1,670}\$\$1,837; clerk of courts, \$\frac{\$6}{678}\$\$7,345; county treasurer, \$\frac{\$\pm\$}{3,339}\$\$3,673; sheriff, \$\frac{\$\pm\$}{1,197}\$\$9,427; register of deeds, \$\frac{\$\pm\$}{6,956}\$\$\$7,651; judge of probate, \$\frac{\$\pm\$}{6,232}\$\$\$\$6,855; register of probate, \$\frac{\$\pm\$}{6,678}\$\$\$\$\$\$\$7,345;

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the salaries of certain Sagadahoc County Officers to reflect the large increase in the cost of living caused by inflation.
