**AN ACT Relating to Municipal Participation in Civil Emergency  
Preparedness Agencies.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Sec. 1.** 37-A MRSA § 59, sub-§ 1, 2nd sentence, as last repealed and replaced by PL 1973, c. 728, § 1, is amended to read:

The Governor ~~after public hearing~~ shall determine those municipalities which shall establish civil emergency preparedness agencies of their own and those which shall participate in and provide support for inter-jurisdictional civil emergency preparedness agencies.

**Sec. 2.** 37-A MRSA § 59, sub-§ 2, 3rd sentence, as last repealed and replaced by PL 1973, c. 728, § 1, is repealed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act would allow for the designation of municipalities to be included in inter-jurisdictional agencies without the necessity of a public hearing.

It would also permit city or town managers to be appointed local directors if the municipality so desires.
