COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 685, L.D. 869,
Bill, "AN ACT Relating to the Definition of a
Real Estate Broker."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the
2nd line after the amending clause (same in L.D)
the underlined figure "3" and inserting in
place thereof the following: '5'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of the amendment is to require
that a person purchasing real estate options
for resale must purchase 5 such options instead
of 3 in order to be classified as a real estate
broker.
