SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Concerning the Powers of Counties.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 60 is enacted to read:

§ 60. Powers in unorganized territory and deorganized townships

A county shall exercise all powers previously granted by the Legislature and all powers and duties granted to municipalities in the unorganized territory and deorganized townships within their boundaries.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to eliminate many of the minor requests which require legislative approval. One recent bill to allow county commissioners to regulate the Sunday sale of liquor is an example.
