STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Require Municipal Clerks and Registration Commissioners to File Lists of Certain Residents with Jury Commissioners.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

14 MRSA § 1254, 1st ¶, as last repealed and replaced by PL 1967, c. 544, § 35, is repealed and the following:

The city and town clerks of the several municipalities or plantations and the registration commissioner of each Indian voting district shall prepare annually a complete list of all people, 18 years or older, located or residing in their locale, and file such list with the jury commissioners of their respective counties on or before the first day of June of each year.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act requires municipal clerks and registration commissioners to prepare an annual list of certain residents and to file these lists with the jury commissioners of their respective counties.
