AN ACT to Require Metal Registration Plates for Snowmobiles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 1973, first ¶, last sentence, as repealed and replaced by PL 1971, c. 356, § 5, is repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

The registration number assigned to a snowmobile shall be displayed on a metal registration plate of such form and size as the commissioner shall determine.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Currently, the Commissioner of Inland Fisheries and Game issues decals for display of the registration number on snowmobiles. However, decals tend to peel off and also cause peeling of the paint where they are applied. This Act would require the use of metal registration plates instead of decals for display of registration numbers on snowmobiles.
