COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 756, L.D. 926, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide Low Cost Financing through the Maine State Housing Authority for Nursing Homes and Similar Facilities for Persons of Low Income."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of paragraph C and inserting in place thereof the following:

'C. To provide a convalescent home, rest home, nursing home or boarding home subject to license under the laws of the State of Maine, provided that at least 30% of the occupants or proposed occupants of such facility shall be recipients or beneficiaries of public assistance from the State of Maine or the Federal Government based upon need;'

Statement of Fact

This amendment specifies the minimum number of low income persons a facility under this Act must have to qualify for Maine State Housing Authority assistance and specifies who qualifies as low income for this purpose.
