HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 752, L.D. 927,
Bill, "AN ACT Concerning the Size of Municipal
Populations in the Statute Requiring or
Authorizing the Appointment of Boards of
Registration."

Amend said Bill by striking out in the
3rd line from the end, before the Statement
of Fact, (2nd line in L.D.) the underlined
figure "3,000" and inserting in place thereof
the underlined figure '3,500'

Statement of Fact

This amendment permits municipalities of
3,500 to 4,000 population to appoint a board
of registration in place of a registrar of voters.
Previously only cities of 4,000 to 5,000 population
had this statutory authorization.
