SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 752, L.D. 927, Bill,  
"AN ACT Concerning the Size of Municipal Populations in the

Amend said Bill by striking out in the 3rd line (same  
in L.D.) the following "~~5,000~~ 4,000" and inserting in place  
thereof the following '5,000' and by striking out in the  
10th line (9th line in L.D.) the following "~~5,000~~ 4,000"  
and inserting in place thereof the following '5,000'

The purpose of this amendment permits municipalities  
of 3,000 to 5,000 population to appoint a board of registration  
in place of a registrar of voters.
