SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT Relating to Hunting Buck Deer.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 2353, first ¶, as last repealed and replaced by PL 1973, c. 208, § 1, is amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read:

During the first 15 days of that open season on deer, it shall be lawful to kill buck deer only.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act, by permitting hunters to shoot buck deer only during the first 15 days of deer season, will decrease the number of does killed, and help insure a healthy deer population.
