AN ACT to Establish Beaver, Coyote and Otter as Endangered Species.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 1906, first ¶, as amended by PL 1971, c. 622, § 34, is further amended by adding at the end a new sentence to read:

The commissioner shall designate beaver, coyote and otter as endangered species.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act will establish beaver, coyote and otter as endangered species.
