STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Increase the Size of Claim Allowable under the Jurisdiction of the Small Claims Court.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

14 MRSA § 7451, as last amended by PL 1971, c. 206, § 1, is further amended to read:

§ 7451. Definitions

A "small claim" is any right of action cognizable by a court of law not involving the title to real estate in which the debt or damage claimed does not exceed \$200 \$400.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill will increase the amount of claim allowable under the jurisdiction of the small claims court from \$200 to \$400.
