STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Increase the Salaries of the Register of Deeds and the Deputy Register of Deeds of Cumberland County.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 2, 4th ¶, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 767, § 3, is further amended in that part relating to register of deeds and deputy register of deeds to read:

register of deeds, ~~\$9,969~~ \$12,000; deputy register of deeds, ~~\$7,975~~ \$9,500;

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act will increase the salaries of the Cumberland County Register of Deeds to \$12,000 per year and the Cumberland County Deputy Register of Deeds to \$9,500 in order to compensate for recent inflation.
