HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 788, L.D. 958, Bill, "AN ACT to Amend the Eating, Lodging and Recreational Place Licensing Law."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§2494" in the 1st paragraph by striking therefrom the underlined words "All fees received by the department under this chapter shall be paid into the State Treasury to the credit of the General Fund." and in the 2nd paragraph by striking therefrom the underlined words "Funds collected in such manner shall be credited to the General Fund."

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§2499." subsection 6 by striking therefrom the underlined words "Such payments shall be credited to the General Fund."

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to remove language which is inconsistent with the dedicated revenue funds intended by the bill.
