STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Exempt Incorporated Nonprofit Volunteer Literacy Programs from the Sales Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- 36 MRSA § 1760, sub-§ 36 is enacted to read:
- 36. Volunteer literacy programs. Sales to incorporated nonprofit volunteer literacy programs.

FISCAL NOTE

The loss of revenue to the State is estimated to be approximately \$500 for a full year.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to exempt incorporated nonprofit volunteer literacy programs from the Sales Tax.
