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### RESOLVE, Providing Funds for the Maintenance of Ocean Beaches.

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**Appropriation; maintenance of ocean beaches. Resolved:** That there is appropriated from the General Fund the sum of \$30,000 to the Town of Scarborough, Cumberland County, and the Town of Old Orchard Beach and the City of Saco, York County, to aid in the cost of cleaning, maintaining and improving the municipal ocean beaches of such city and towns. The breakdown shall be as follows:
