RESOLVE, to Reimburse Richard Lufkin of Thorndike for Property Damage Caused by Water Runoff from State Highway.

Richard Lufkin; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Highway Fund the sum of \$1,248 to be paid to Richard Lufkin of Thorndike as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for damage to his farmland caused by water runoff from State Highway Route No. 220.

STATEMENT OF FACT

During the fall and spring of 1973 and 1974 Mr. Richard Lufkin of Thorn-dike suffered extensive damage to his farmland caused by water runoff from State Highway Route No. 220.
