COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 280, L.D. 992, Bill,
"AN ACT Providing Funds for Bancroft School Facility for
Seriously Disturbed Children at Owls Head.

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the title and
inserting in place thereof the following: 'AN ACT Providing
Funds for Seriously Disturbed Children in Maine.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out everything after
the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the
following:

'Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General
Fund the sum of \$100,000 to the Department of Mental Health
and Corrections to provide funds for Seriously Disturbed
Children for the current biennium. All funds appropriated
under this Act shall not lapse, but shall remain a continuing
carrying account until June 30, 1977.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides funds to fund a state-wide
program for seriously disturbed children in Maine under the
supervision of the Department of Mental Health and Corrections.
