**AN ACT Appropriating Funds for Rebuilding the Dam
at Lake Wesserunsett in Somerset County.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of Madison the sum of \$25,000 to aid in rebuilding the dam on Wesserunsett Lake in the Town of Madison in Somerset County. This sum may be used by the Town of Madison to match other moneys which are available.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Total cost of rebuilding this dam to the Town of Madison is estimated at about \$75,000. This lake is the home of Lakewood Theatre, Abnaki Campground and the Skowhegan Art School, all of which attract people from all over this State and the United States. Matching will be subject to final cost of a \$75,000 estimate at this time.
