AN ACT to Increase Per Diem Allowances for Members of the State Board of Arbitration and Conciliation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. 26 MRSA § 911, 6th sentence, as amended by PL 1969, c. 450, § 1, is further amended to read:

Members of the board shall each receive ~~\$50~~ \$75 a day for their services for the time actually employed in the discharge of their official duties.

Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated from the General Fund to the Department of Manpower Affairs, Bureau of Labor and Industry, Maine State Board of Arbitration and Conciliation, the sum of \$4,500 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act will provide for increasing the per diem allowances for members of the Maine State Board of Arbitration and Conciliation from \$50 per day to \$75 per day and will assist in maintaining competent personnel on that board.
