COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" TO H.P. 825, L.D. 1008, Bill,
"AN ACT to Allow Payment of Unemployment Compensation Benefits
During Labor Disputes Caused by Failure of the Employer to
Correct Hazardous Working Conditions."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the
amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'D. He became unemployed because of a strike or lockout
caused by an employer's willful failure to observe the
terms of the safety and health section of a union
contract; an employer's willful failure to comply in a
timely fashion with an official citation for a violation
of federal and state laws involving occupational safety
and health; or the quitting of labor by an employee
or employees in good faith because of an abnormally
dangerous condition for work at the place of employment
of such employee or employees; provided that such strike
or lockout shall not extend past the time of the employer's
compliance with the safety and health section of the union
contract, the employer's compliance with the official
citation, or the finding that an abnormally dangerous
condition does not exist by a federal or state official
empowered to issue official citations for violation of
federal and state laws involving occupational safety and
health.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to clarify the purpose of the original bill.
