HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 293, L.D. 1018, Bill, "AN
ACT Relating to Motor Vehicle Excise Tax."

Amend said Bill by inserting before the Statement
of Fact the following underlined, blocked paragraph:

of paragraph C
'The first paragraph/shall not apply to vehicles which
are owned by a corporation engaged principally in the
construction industry and which are temporarily
housed in a municipality pursuant to a particular
contract whose actual duration is 24 months or less.
The excise tax on such vehicles shall be paid to
the municipality in which the registered office
of the corporation in this State is located. As used
in this paragraph, "construction industry" means
that industry consisting of employees and employers
engaged in construction, demolition, repair or moving
of buildings, roads, highways, bridges, streets, alleys,
sewers, ditches, sewage disposal plants, waterworks,
airports and all other structures or works whether
private or public on which construction work is per-
formed.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that the excise tax
on certain motor vehicles owned by a construction
company temporarily housing them in a municipality
shall be paid to the municipality containing the
registered office of the corporation.
