AN ACT Authorizing the Commissioner of Conservation to Confer and Cooperate with the United States Geological Survey in Certain Instances.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

35 MRSA § 10 is amended to read:

§ 10. Conferences with United States Geological Survey

The ~~commission~~ Commissioner of Conservation may confer with the director or the representative of the United States Geological Survey and ~~accepts~~ accept its cooperation in the prosecution of ~~hydrologic~~ hydrological and geological surveys, and the preparation of a contour topographic survey and map of the State.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This Act authorizes the Commissioner of Conservation to cooperate with the United States Geological Survey in the prosecution of hydrological and geological surveys and in preparing certain maps. The section being amended now authorizes the Public Utilities Commission to undertake such cooperation.
