AN ACT Concerning Snowmobile Registration Fees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

12 MRSA § 1972, as last amended by PL 1973, c. 788, § 45, is further amended by adding a new sentence after the 4th sentence to read:

For each \$6 distributed to the owner's municipality under this section, \$3 shall be used by that municipality to acquire, construct and maintain snowmobile trails in that municipality.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill provides that ½ of the municipal portion of each snowmobile registration fee shall be used by the municipality to which the portion is distributed to acquire, construct and maintain snowmobile trails.
