SENATE AMENDMENT"^A " to S.P. 297, L.D. 1023, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Filing Requirements for Perfecting a Security Interest in Mobile Homes under the Uniform Commercial Code."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of that part designated "(a)" and inserting in place thereof the following:

> '(a) When the collateral is consumer goods, then in the office of the clerk of the municipality of the debtor's residence unless (i) the debtor (i) is not a resident of this State or (ii) the debtor is a resident of an unorganized place or (iii) the collateral is a mobile home as defined in Title 10, section 1402, subsection 2, then in the office of the Secretary of State;'

Statement of Fact

This amendment clarifies the language pertaining to the filing requirement for a security interest when collateral is a mobile home.
