# STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

AN ACT to Repeal the Law Requiring Fixed Wage Rates to be Paid on Public Works.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

26 MRSA §§ 1303 to 1315, as amended, are repealed.

#### FISCAL NOTE

If the present law concerning fixed wage rates had not been in effect from 1968 to 1975, the State would have saved \$11,520,000.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to repeal the statutes regarding fixing of wage rates on state public works. All such labor will still be subject to the state minimum wage.
