COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 873, L.D. 1047, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Premiums and Rebates by Class A Restaurants under the Liquor Laws."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the amending clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit Class A restaurants and hotels from offering special package plans or offering price premiums as a means of promoting attendance on licensed premises.'

Licensed clubs may offer prizes, gratuities or other inducements, otherwise legal, as a means of promoting attendance on licensed premises.

Class A restaurants, hotels and clubs may advertise their special package plans.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to prohibit Class A restaurants and hotels from offering prizes and gratuities as a means of promoting the consumption of alcohol.
