COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 883, L. D. 1055, RESOLVE, to Reimburse Thomas F. Oechsle of East Holden for Damage to Beehives by Bear.

Amend said Resolve by striking out in the 3rd line (2nd line in L. D.) the figure "\$200" and inserting in place thereof the figure '\$100'; and by striking out in the 5th line (4th line in L.D.) the words "and damage to 2 other beehives"

Statement of Fact

This amendment clarifies Mr. Oechsle's claim by showing that he is seeking reimbursement only for the destruction of his beehives on October 4, 1975. The beehives damaged in July were repaired and are the same beehives which were totally destroyed in October. Mr. Oechsle is not seeking reimbursement for the July damage, which he repaired, but only for the beehives totally destroyed in October.
