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**RESOLVE, to Reimburse Thomas F. Oechsle of East Holden for Damage to Beehives by Bear.**

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**Thomas F. Oechsle; reimbursed. Resolved:** There is appropriated from the General Fund to Thomas F. Oechsle of East Holden the sum of \$200 as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for loss of 2 beehives and honey and damage to 2 other beehives caused by bear.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Mr. Oechsle had 2 beehives torn apart and damaged on July 5th, 8th, 15th and 17th of 1974 and had 2 beehives totally destroyed on October 4, 1974. Although Mr. Oechsle attempted to file a claim under the appropriate statute for reimbursement for this damage, he did not file within the required 24 hours after the damage occurred and thus his claim cannot be allowed under that statute. Therefore, his only recourse is to request the Legislature to reimburse him for the damage caused his hives by bear.
