### STATE OF MAINE

## IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Waldoboro for Assisting in the Capture of Escapees from the Maine State Prison in Thomaston.

Town of Waldoboro; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund to the Town of Waldoboro the sum of \$1,497 as reimbursement for the expense undertaken by the town during 1974 in helping to capture escapees from the Maine State Prison in Thomaston.

#### STATEMENT OF FACT

The first town traveling south from Thomaston on Route I which maintains a police department is the small town of Waldoboro. Numerous assists by the Waldoboro Police Department to the State of Maine have included the expense of putting additional policemen on patrol on the numerous backroads in the area as well as maintaining roadblocks.
