RESOLVE, to Reimburse Norman Salisbury of Amherst for Economic Loss to his Business Caused by Highway Repair.

Norman Salisbury; reimbursed. Resolved: That there is appropriated from the General Fund to Norman Salisbury of Amherst, Maine, the sum of \$3,000 as a full and final settlement of his claim against the State for economic loss suffered by his retail store because of highway construction on Route 9.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Mr. Salisbury's store suffered a business loss of \$3,000 from March until July 2, 1973, while traffic to his store was stopped by the removal of ledge on Route 9. This resolve will reimburse Mr. Salisbury for that loss.
