HOUSE AMENDMENT "B" to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to
H.P. 856, L.D. 1070, Bill, "AN ACT Concerning the Filling
of the Office of Register of Deeds."

Amend said Amendment by inserting at the end before
the Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 4. Transition. If, on the day before the
effective date of this Act, the deputy register of Cumberland
County is serving as acting register, he shall continue to
serve as acting register until December 31, 1976 and shall,
during that time, perform all duties and services required
by a register of deeds during such vacancy, complete all
unfinished business, receive the same compensation and be
subject to the same liabilities as a register of deeds, and
his certificate shall have the same effect as if made by the
register.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment exempts the deputy register of Cumberland
County who is serving as acting register on the effective date
of this Act from the application of this bill.
