HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 321,
.D. 1098, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for the Appointment of
Deputy District Attorneys."

Amend said amendment by adding at the end before the Statement
of Fact the following:

'Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 3, the full-time
assistant district attorney designated as the deputy district
attorney shall be paid a salary set by the district attorney
which shall not be less than \$17,000 nor more than \$20,000.'

The purpose of this amendment is to keep qualified district
attorneys in office.
