Amend said amendment by adding at the end before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Notwithstanding the provisions of subsection 3, the full-time assistant district attorney designated as the deputy district attorney shall be paid a salary set by the district attorney which shall not be less than \$17,000 nor more than \$20,000.'
