SENATE AMENDMENT "A" to S.P. 321, L.D. 1098,
Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for the Appointment of
Deputy District Attorneys."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything
after the enacting clause and inserting in place
thereof the following:


'30 MRSA §554-A, sub-§1, as enacted by
PL 1973, c. 567, §19, is amended by adding at the
end a new paragraph to read:

Each district attorney may designate one full-
time assistant district attorney to be his deputy
who shall, in the absence of the district attorney,
act in his stead and have the authority, duties and
responsibilities of the district attorney.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides for a full-time
assistant district attorney to be designated to act
in the absence of the district attorney without
increasing the salary limitation for full-time
assistant district attorneys.
