HOUSE AMENDMENT" B "to COMMITTEE AMENDMENT" A" to  
HP 907, LD 1106, Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for  
Supervision of Elections by Municipal Clerks."

Amend said amendment by striking out all of  
the 4th, 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th and 9th lines and  
inserting in place thereof the following:

'In a town, the clerk of the municipality shall  
be the supervisor of all elections, shall appoint  
a warden and may appoint one or more deputy wardens  
to assist him in his duties on election day. The  
clerk may designate himself as warden or deputy  
warden but neither the warden nor any deputy warden  
shall be an officer of a municipal committee of a  
political party.'

Statement of Fact

This amendment provides that neither the warden  
nor deputy warden can be an officer of a municipal  
committee of a political party.
