COMMITTEE AMENDMENT" A " to HP 907, LD 1106,
Bill, "AN ACT to Provide for Supervision of
Elections by Municipal Clerks."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the
3rd sentence of that part designated "§531."
and inserting in place thereof the following:

'In a town, the clerk of the municipality shall
be the supervisor of all elections, shall appoint
a warden and may appoint one or more deputy
wardens to assist him in his duties on election
day. The clerk may designate himself as warden
or deputy warden.'

Further amend said Bill by striking out all
of the 6th sentence of that part designated "§531."

the language of the bill.
