SENATE AMENDMENT" A "to S.P. 327, L.D. 1113,  
Resolve, Providing Funds for Clients in Special Age  
Groups Served by Cerebral Palsy Centers.

Amend said Resolve by striking out everything  
after the title and inserting in place thereof  
the following:

'Cerebral Palsy Centers; appropriation. Resolved:  
That there is appropriated from the General Fund to  
the Cerebral Palsy Centers in Maine the sum of  
\$40,000 for the biennium to be used to help support  
a program of infant services, extended adult ser-  
vices, prevocational services, diagnostic and  
evaluation services and therapy services for clients  
ages 0 - 4 and ages 21 and over who are not covered  
by existing laws. The breakdown shall be as  
follows:
