AN ACT to Authorize County Commissioners to Provide or Contract
for Certain County and Municipal Services.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

30 MRSA § 425 is enacted to read:

§ 425. Powers of county commissioners generally

The county commissioners of all counties may themselves provide or contract with counties, municipalities, towns or townships to provide services that said units of government are now authorized to perform. The county commissioners shall assess the municipalities receiving these services for their proportionate share of the costs.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to authorize county commissioners to provide or contract for certain services which counties or municipalities are authorized to perform.
